What is psychosis?

Psychosis is a **complex medical condition** where changes in the brain interfere with a person's experience of the world. Psychosis most often develops in the late teens and young adulthood. Symptoms can go undetected until **a person's life is substantially disrupted**. Early warning signs include:

- Hearing or seeing things that aren't there
- False or bizarre beliefs that make sense only to the individual
- Disorganized thoughts or speech
- Withdrawal from others
- Dramatic deterioration in work, school, relationships, or self-care
- · Behavior that is out of place for the setting
- Feeling anxious, irritable, or depressed

Psychosis is more common than you think. It affects 3 in 100 people. However, many people living with symptoms go years before they get the right services. Evidence shows that the earlier the intervention, the better the long term outcomes. **Early intervention matters.**
